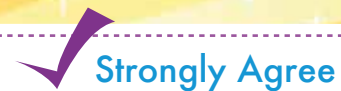

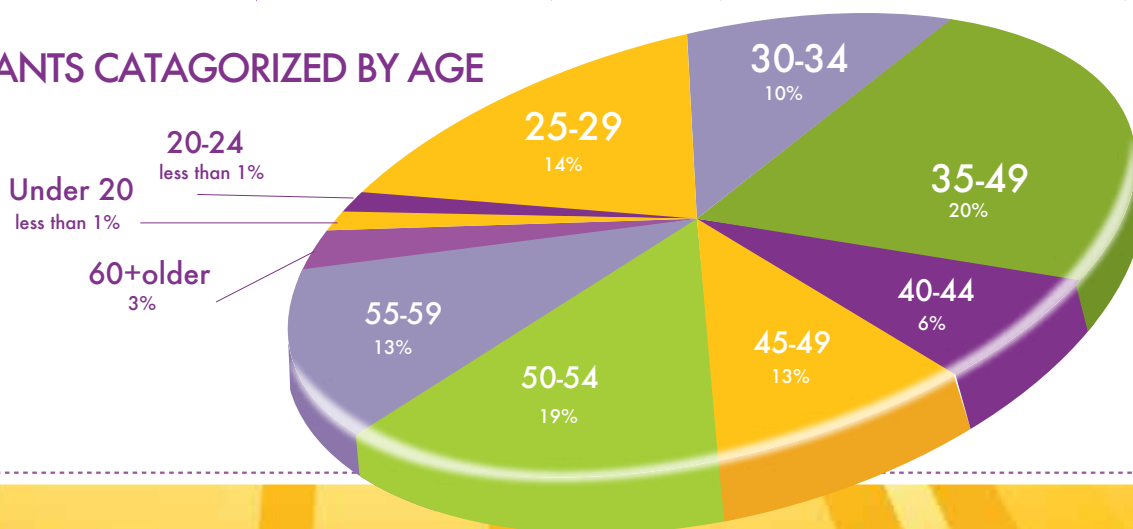

PARTICIPANTS CATEGORIZED BY AGE

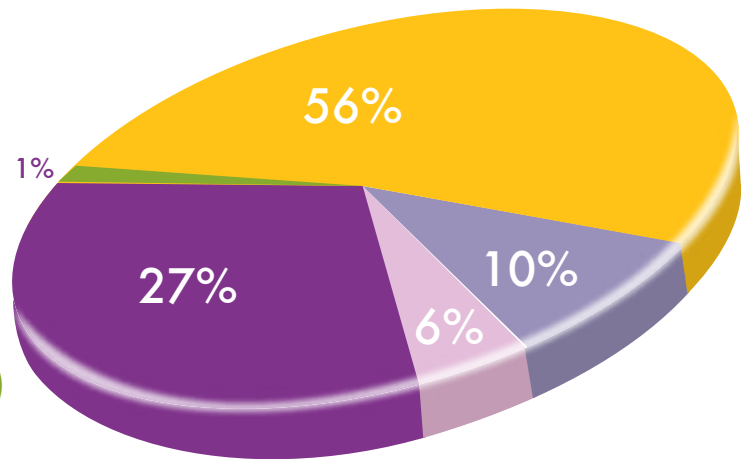


PARTICIPANTS CATEGORIZED BY HIGHEST LEVEL OF EDUCATION

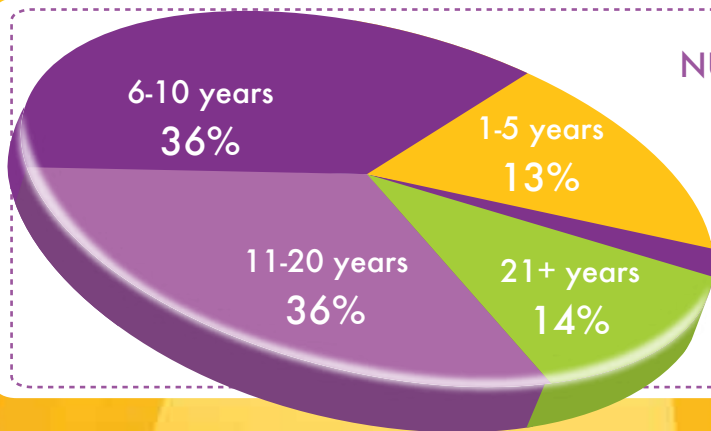
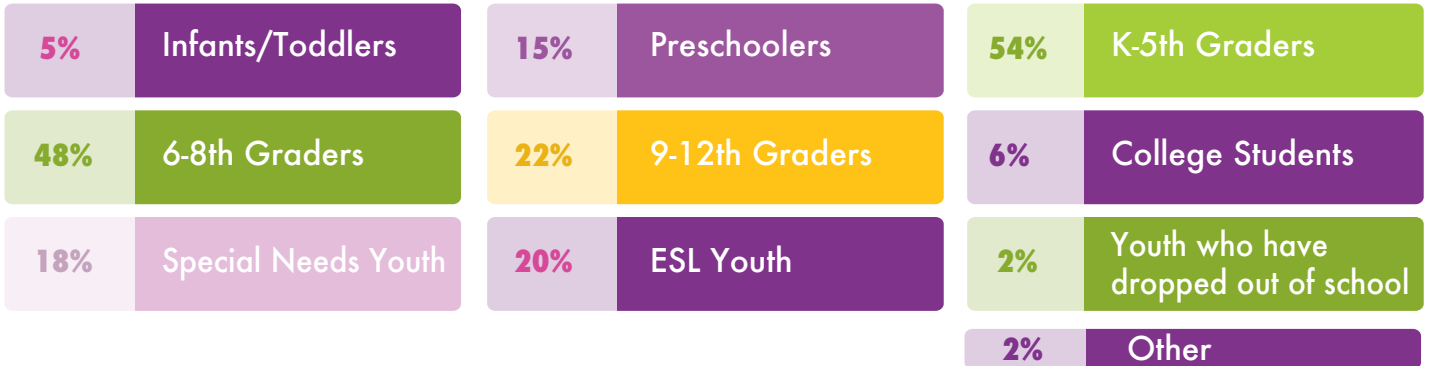
- 27%** **Upper-Level Administration**

- 10%** **Capacity-Building**
(Provide professional development, technical assistance, monitor programs, evaluate programs, and/or conduct research)
- 1%** **Other**
